PISA (Programme for International Student Assessment) is an international study that was launched by the OECD in 1997 and first administered in 2000. Every 3 years the PISA survey provides comparative data on the performance of 15-year-olds in reading, mathematics, and science. In addition, each cycle explores a distinct “innovative domain”. For PISA 2018 this new dimension was Global Competence. PISA now covers 80 countries all over the world (<https://www.oecd.org/pisa>). PISA results have informed education policy discussions both at a national and a global level.
